BANGLADESH AT 50: MAKING RAPID PROGRESS

Today, Bangladesh is one of the fastest growing economies in Asia. It has transitioned to a middle-income country progressing significantly in terms of both development and social welfare parameters. Recognised as a multi-party democracy, Bangladesh has improved its energy and transport sectors, maintained better human development indicators than its neighbours, and lifted a substantial section of its population from abject poverty. *Bangladesh at 50* traces the country's history since 1971,

while also commenting on the possible concerns that societal, political and institutional structures are likely to face in the future.

It also studies Bangladesh's relationship with the world and with India.
