

MODI COULDN'T CATCH EVEN A SINGLE CORRUPT: AUTHOR

Two years after demonetisation, we are seeing its lingering impact, especially in the restlessness of farmers, said C. Ram Manohar Reddy, author of *Demonetisation and Black Money* at the Hyderabad Literary Festival.

He said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi went ahead with the step to reclaim his narrative as leader of people, but “demonetisation was a decision taken against every piece of sane advice. He was able to seize the initiative because people were angry at corruption.”

Calling demonetisation a “nuclear bomb” to root out corruption, he said, “people are tired and two years later not a single person with black money has been brought out.”
